

## Activities Link to Results Organiser

## **Results Organiser and Activities**

Activities can be linked to Results Organiser which can then be used to analyse outcomes and aims and so assess the level of success or failure of an Activity. For example if you define a Results Organiser Template that has Every Child Matters (ECM) Outcomes as the Aspects and with marks 1-10, by linking an Activity to this template you can track trends in the ECM Outcomes.


1. Click Results Organiser. This link will only be active if your Local Authority has a current licence for PULSE **and** the Service Team has had at least one Activity Template added in CSS Service Teams Administration.


If these criteria have been fulfilled then the link will still be inactive until the Activity has at least one linked person and has been saved.



The Select Template window will open. This lists all the Results Organiser Templates that are appropriate to the Service Team that is responsible for this Activity.

2. Double click on the Template you would like to link to this Activity or click on the template name and click **Select** or **Open** to display the Results Organiser Grid.






You can only link one Results Organiser Template at a time to an Activity.





## Activities Link to Results Organiser

- 3. Enter the results directly in the grid (double click and type) or, if the associated results are already held in the database for those Aspects you can select the required Aspect(s) and click Populate Results to return All Results data.
- 4. You can save edited data to the database by clicking the Save icon. Results History can be viewed by right clicking on a cell. Where more than one result per Aspect per person is stored in the database a small RED triangle is displayed in the cell; the hover information will indicate (Multiple Results). Right click to view the history.



If you wish to use functions that are not available with this modal window version of Results organiser then you can save the grid as a **Marksheet** and open this Marksheet in Results Management.
