Important Infrastructure Changes

Crystal Reports Upgrade

The One Education Spring 2018 Release (3.65) requires that you upgrade to the Crystal Reports 2016 Runtime Version (v13.0.20). All customers should consider their upgrade methodology to ensure that you can test the runtime thoroughly. This is especially important for environments that host their LIVE and TEST environments on the same server. It is strongly recommended that you contact the One Education Application Support team to discuss the best method for upgrading your environment.

One Portals API

There is a new key, DatabaseConnectionStringRegistered, that must be added to the One Portals API web.config file. You must provide connection details to your One Education Oracle database and the dataset_registered schema credentials.



Citizen Portal

Usability Improvement

Across the application pages of Citizen Portal for A&T, all the **Yes-No** sliders have been changed to check boxes. This helps with usability, provides a consistent experience, and removes potential bilingual translation issues for Welsh LAs.



B2B:Student

New Functionality

B2B:Student will support SIMS Primary. There is a migration process that must be completed within B2B:Student for each school that requires SIMS Primary support.

Early Years

New Functionality

- When a provider reviews a placement request that has been submitted by a parent using the Citizen portal, they can now display the parent's contact details.
- The Not Checked button has been removed from the Early Years Pupil Premium Bulk ECS Check screen. This is due to a change in DfE policy that once a child is eligible for EYPP they remain eligible (whilst they are in receipt of the early years entitlement) and don't need to be rechecked.
- Local Authorities that record interim hours by funded service can now break down the interim hours into universal and extended hours by age group

eStart

New Functionality

The eStart person delete functionality has been updated to be compliant with GDPR regulations. Deleting a person (e.g., parent, carer, child or family) from eStart now removes all information about them from all the relevant database tables. Deleting a person is irreversible.

Phonics

This return includes yearly changes only. In order to ensure that the correct year is being included, the automated yearly tables update for **Key Stage 1 – Phonics** should be run in the v4 Client via **Tools | Administration | Attainment Projects Calendar Year Update** routine. Please import the latest 7.180 AMPARK and CTF Translation files.

A new handbook, *Statutory Phonics Screening Check Handbook*, is available on the **One Publications** website.

EYFSP

This return includes yearly changes only. In order to ensure that the correct year is being included, the automated yearly tables update for EYFSP should be run in the v4 Client via Tools | Administration | Attainment Projects Calendar Year Update routine. Please import the latest 7.180 AMPARK and CTF Translation files.

Key Stage 1

- The following changes have been made to the assessment component valid scores.
 - The new TA maladministration (Q) code has been added to Reading, Writing, Mathematics and Science.
 - Disapplied (U) code has been removed from Science.

As the yearly tables will be updated during the upgrade to the One Education Spring 2018 (3.65) release, you will not need to run the Key Stage 1 automated yearly table update routine.

Statutory Wales Specific

Post-16

IMPORTANT NOTE: The Welsh Government recently issued a revised specification (version 2.2) which includes some changes to learning activity and programmes. These changes will be available in the One Education Spring 2018 Release Service Pack 1 (3.65.100). In the meantime, we recommend waiting until we support the new specification before importing the 2018 Post 16 Census file.

The following changes are based on v2.0 of the Post-16 specification:

- Yearly changes to support the import 2018 PLASC Post-16 Census files. 2018 Post-16 files can now be imported in the v4 client via Focus | Data Management | Import | Import File Specifications as Welsh Census FT-18.
- One Education supports importing the following details to PLASC tables:
 - New Pupil Programme details have been introduced
 - Some changes have been made to the Post-16 learning activity:
 - The learning activity reference is no longer collected.
 - New QWAD (Qualification Wales Approval/Designation Number) and Programme Identifier have been introduced.

System

New Functionality

Support for longer surnames and forenames

To ensure GDPR compliance, a UDF has been added to the areas in the v4 Client and v4 Online where names are entered. Surnames and forenames up to 250 characters can be entered into the UDF.

Portal users cannot enter long surnames and forenames, however a message has been added to the portals prompting users with longer names to contact their LA, and the LA can enter the names in the v4 Client or v4 Online as appropriate.

GDPR Consent

The following features have been added to One Education to meet GDPR consent requirements:

- The LA can define and publish a data policy/consent statement which can be updated as and when required.
- Presentation of the data policy/consent statement to individuals during registration for a new Citizen Portal account - the data policy must be agreed to by the individual at this point before being allowed to register and use a Citizen Portal account.
- Consent to be renewed by Citizen Portal account holders each time an updated version of the data policy/consent statement is published by the LA.
- The data policy/consent statement to be agreed to when assisted applications are being completed on behalf of citizens using Provider Portal functionality (for example during a Two Year Old Funding assisted application).
- Citizens can withdraw their consent. The LA will be notified that it needs to process a withdrawal/refusal to re-consent when it occurs.
- Citizen Portal account holders to view a chronological record of dates and times when they have accepted the terms of a data policy/consent statement.
- LA Administrators to view a chronological record of dates and times when individual CP account holders have accepted the terms of a data policy/consent statement.
- The LA to view a list of people/Citizen Portal accounts for which consent has been withdrawn, and to mark that withdrawal as processed once local procedures have been completed.
